

# Technical Requirement for Environmental Products

## The Certificable Technical Requirement for Environmental Labelling Products

### Non- aluminium Pressure Cooker

HJBZ 31—1998

---

#### 1 Scope

This technical requirement specifies the basic requirements, technical contents and test methods for environmental labelling products of non-aluminum pressure cooker.

This technical requirement shall apply to all pressure cookers primarily made from materials of iron or stainless steel.

#### 2 Standards cited

Provisions in the following standards are cited in this technical requirement, and therefore form the provisions in this standard. They have the same effectiveness as the technical requirement itself.

GB 4806.1—94 Hygienic standard for foodstuff rubber products

GB 5009.63—1996 Method for analysis of hygienic standard of enamel for food containers

GB 9684—88 Hygienic standard for stainless steel food containers and table wares

GB 1678—89 Hygienic standard for polytetrafluorethylene used as inner coating of food containers

GB 1679—89 Method for analysis of hygienic standard of polytetrafluorethylene-coating for inner wall of food container

GB 11681—89 Method for analysis of hygienic standard of stainless steel food containers and table wares

GB 13484—92 Enamelled ware in contact with food

In case of the criteria above are revised, the latest version should be applied.

#### 3 Basic requirements

3.1 Quality of products shall conform with requirement of relevant product quality standard.

3.2 Pollutant emission of the company should be obliged to conform with pollutant emission standards nationally or locally.

#### 4 Technical contents

4.1 Products should not use alumina-based material as main material.

4.2 The part of products contacting with food should conform with requirements in GB 9684—88.

4.3 Teflon coating of product contacting with food should conform with requirements specified in GB 11678—89.

4.4 The enamel part of products contacting with food should conform with requirements in GB 13484—92.

4.5 The rubber part of products contacting with food should conform with requirements in GB 4806.1—94.

#### 5 Test

5.1 Technical contents specified in 4.1 should be proved by method of field inspection.

5.2 Technical contents specified in 4.2 should be determined by adopting analytic method in GB11681—89.
